She purchased four fans at Wal-Mart to be used to help cool the blue (obedience) building. The Kustanbauters took the contract to the Fairgrounds and made sure that the blue building was included. The porta potties and the golf cart have been ordered. Veterinarian, Kara Nelson, will not be able to be at the shows, but we will have ample coverage with local vets who are on call. Carol has the photographer arranged, and the tents are coming, She purchased NNKC pens to give out with the two-day catalogs. We will be using the Days In and Super 8 motels for the judges and stewards. We have applied to hold an agility match at the shows. The judges list has been approved, and food from the Grange has been arranged.

Media Proposal from *Pets Planet* – *Pets Planet* is a monthly free magazine with 5,000 newsprint copies circulated throughout Centre County, and is dedicated to sharing information about animals. It is subsidized by advertising from local businesses and individuals. *Pets Planet's* Co-Founders and Co-Publishers, Connie Dunlap and Gara Smith, were present at the meeting to present their proposal to the Board. In general, they would like to initiate a continuing partnership with us, where they provide the club with advertisement and exposure to the public, in return for articles provided by the club, and the ability to advertise on the back cover of our show catalog, and to set up a display at our shows. The club voted to pay \$480 (\$40 per month) to *Pets Planet* for space for an article in the paper for a year from July 2004 through June 2005. *Pets Planet* will provide an advertisement for the back of our show catalog, and will set up a display at the shows.

Club Display Board at Wiscoy – Renie Adrian is working on the board which will be displayed one Saturday at Wiscoy, and requested photos from club members of our dogs and club events. She will make copies and return photos to you if you like.
